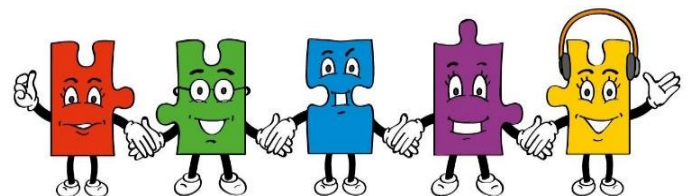


LORIC Day
