Key Vocabulary		Mathematical Skills
Positional language	E.g. upside down, sideways, next, before, after, in between, turn, flip, first, last, forwards, backwards.	
Ordinal numbers	E.g. First, second, third, fourth etc.	
Language of time	E.g. Days of the week, yesterday, today, tomorrow.	
Sequence	An ordered list of numbers, shapes or objects.	
Estimate	Work out an answer that is nearly right.

- Exploring the Numicon shapes e.g. covering the baseboard and using mathematical language to describe their choices.




- Exploring the number rods.




- Exploring ordering Numicon shapes.

- Reciting the counting sequence of number names.




- Counting small collections of objects accurately.
