
Key Vocabulary

Mathematical Skills

- Recognise that it is important to be well organised and to work systematically.
- Make a general statement after noticing something happening regularly.
- Describe objects according to their attributes.
- Sort objects according to their attributes.
- Are able to describe and sort a 'not' set.

Mathematical Methods

- Following rules to make sets e.g. organising sets of objects by colour, shape, size etc.
- Sorting fruit—the 'not' set e.g.



- Sorting buttons e.g. grouping buttons based on their attributes.
- Organising sets using a grid.
