Order	Arranging numbers, shapes or objects into a sequence or pattern.	
Sequence	An ordered list of numbers, shapes or objects.	
Comparative words	Different, similar, thicker, thinner, longer, shorter, wider, narrower, bigger, smaller.	
Numeral	A symbol or group of symbols that represent a number.	
Combine	To join together.	
add	Combine two or more amounts or numbers to make a total.	
Altogether/total	The whole amount of numbers or objects combined.	
Equals/makes	The same in number or amount.	


Mathematical Methods
